Megan Thee Stallion wearing Dolce & Gabbana

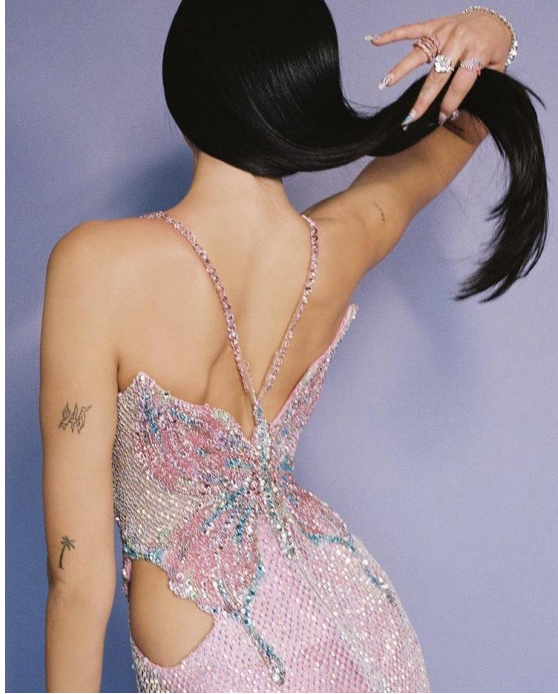

Taylor Swift wearing Oscar de la Renta

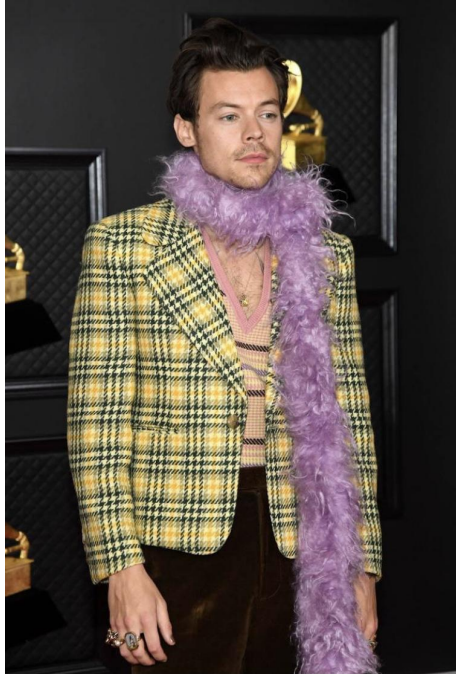
